## STICKY STAINED GLASS

**Activity** Sticky Stained Glass

**Activity type** Learning Centre activity

**Duration** 75-90 min

**The children will:**

- understand the meaning of some Christian symbols
- understand the purpose of stained glass windows

**They will do this by:**

- Briefly exploring some of the stained glass windows inside the Cathedral
- Using a template to make their own using tissue paper OR
- Designing their own window

**Key vocabulary:** Candle, sun, cross, dove, halo, bible

**Before the visit why not.....**

- Introduce the children to the key vocabulary
- Learn the meaning of 'symbolism', research signs and symbols around the school and in the local community

**After the visit why not.....**

- Brighten up your classroom window by displaying your sticky stained glass then send us a picture
