Max sessions per day: 3*



Aim: To introduce 12 key symbols of the Christian Faith and how they relate to worship and stories from the Bible

Children will do this by:

- Exploring what a symbol is and how it is used
- Interactive story telling using Lego
- Discovering where the symbols are used in the Cathedral
- Designing and make a clay tile featuring Christian symbols of faith
- Explaining the symbols they choose to make



Key Vocabulary: Alpha and Omega, Baptism, Bible, Candle, Chalice, Communion, Cross, Crucifix, Dove, Fish, Font, Paten, Sun, Trinity

What we provide:

- Lego (1 set between 2)
- Clay and tools
- Work mat

School to provide:


- Chairs and tables (suitable set up for pair work)
- Projector and screen

Before the session why not:

- Introduce the key vocabulary
- Go on a symbol hunt around school

After the session why not:

- Paint your clay tiles and send us a photo
- Make your school logo out of Lego
- Research symbols from other faiths



****Understanding Christianity: Salvation 2B.6** Make clear connections between the Christian belief in Jesus' death as a sacrifice and how Christians celebrate Holy Communion/Lord's Supper.

Incarnation/God 2A.3 Describe how Christians show their beliefs about God the Trinity in worship (in baptism and prayer, for example) and in the way they live.

SAMS AT1: Use religious vocabulary to describe some of the key features of Christianity. Make links between beliefs and stories. Begin to identify the impact religion has on the believer's lifestyle


Identify what influences them, making links between aspects of their own and others' experiences

AT2: Ask important questions about religious beliefs and lifestyles, linking their own and others' responses

Art: KS1 To develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space. **KS2** To improve their mastery of art and design techniques, including drawing, painting and sculpture with a range of materials [for example, pencil, charcoal, paint, clay]

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
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
