Skills Needed	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Some embroidery experience– canvas work or cross- stitch would be ideal but is not essential• Accuracy in stitching• Experience of using charts for embroidery• Good eyesight – it is very fine work!• Neat and methodical worker
Training Provided	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• An insight into the history of the piece• Instruction in the order of working the patterns• Safeguarding training is mandatory for all volunteers
Work Schedule	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Each group work for 2 hours each. Sessions are allocated dependent upon availability, flexibility and space within the team
