Description	<p>The position of Children’s group volunteer supports the worship and mission of the Cathedral as it seeks to support and engage young people with the development of their Christian faith.</p> <p>Volunteers key responsibilities will include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lead/ support with activity sessions • Having regular conversations with Youth Mission Enabler regarding planning of activities <p>The Junior Church group runs during the Eucharist, starting at 10.15 until 11am, and is aimed at primary school aged children.</p> <p>Youth Church runs from 5-6pm on a Sunday, and is aimed at young people in secondary school.</p>
Skills Needed	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Worshipping member of the Cathedral congregation who embodies the values of the Cathedral • Age 18 or over (Safeguarding requirements) • Good communicator, and able to work well in a team • Able to respond to the needs of a diverse group of young people, showing respect for their individual Christian journey • Dynamic and able to act appropriately to changing needs of group
