



Made in Lockdown is a pop-up art exhibition at Peterborough Cathedral from Friday 21st January to Friday 18th February 2022

Terms and Conditions of Entry

Entries can only be accepted from artists who agree to abide by these terms and conditions.

CRITERIA

1. Works of art must be in one of these three formats:

Smaller two-dimensional pieces, maximum size 50cm wide x 200cm including the frame. The work must be framed, with two eyelets or some other means of attaching picture wire or cord securely on the back. Cathedral staff will add the picture wire or cord and the items will hang from a batten.

Larger two-dimensional pieces, over 50cm wide but no more than 120cm wide x 120cm high, including the frame. The Cathedral will display these items on free standing easels. Please note that we can accept fewer pieces at this size.

Three-dimensional pieces must be a minimum size of roughly 15cm x 15cm x 15cm and a maximum size of 250cm x 250cm x 250cm. The Cathedral will display these items on a table or, for larger items, on the floor.

Examples of the kinds of work which will be accepted are drawings, paintings, prints, collages, framed textile pieces, three-dimensional pieces in wood, metal, ceramic or recycled materials.

Video, sound or performance pieces will not be accepted.

2. Works of art must have been created during the UK's Covid-19 lockdown periods of 2020 and early 2021 or in response to the current Covid situation.
3. Peterborough Cathedral reserves the right to reject entries for safety reasons or which it considers incompatible with its values (see www.peterborough-cathedral.org.uk/vision.aspx).

HOW TO ENTER (FREE OF CHARGE)

1. Each artist may submit up to 3 works. Depending on space available, it is possible that only one work will be selected.
2. Entries will only be accepted with a completed entry form. You will find the entry form online here: www.peterborough-cathedral.org.uk/exhibition.aspx#form or you can contact the Cathedral to ask for a paper copy to be posted to you. Email exhibitions@peterborough-cathedral.org.uk or call 01733 355315 (during office hours).

If you would prefer to submit an audio file of your answers to the questions on the entry form, please attach the audio file to an email, with a photograph of your work, and send it to exhibitions@peterborough-cathedral.org.uk.

3. Stage 1 – complete the entry form and return it with a photograph of your work(s), no later than **Monday 10th January 2022**. The work does not have to be already framed at this point.
4. Stage 2 – the Cathedral will contact you by Wednesday 12th January to let you know whether or not your work is included in the exhibition.
5. Stage 3 – if your work is included, you will be invited to bring it to the South Transept Gate of the Cathedral at one of these times:

Saturday 15th January, between 10.00am and 1.00pm

Monday 17th January, between 10.00am and 4.00pm

The Cathedral cannot offer flexibility on these times.

COLLECTION OF YOUR WORK AFTER THE EXHIBITION

1. The exhibition closes on Friday 18th February. All works must be collected between these times:

Saturday 19th February, between 10.00am and 1.00pm

Monday 21st February, between 10.00am and 4.00pm

The Cathedral cannot offer flexibility on these times.

2. If you cannot make it during these times, please arrange for someone else to collect your work for you and let the Cathedral know in advance who this will be.
3. Any items left uncollected by Friday 25th February will become the property of Peterborough Cathedral and may be disposed of.

OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Artists submit their work to the exhibition at their own risk. Whilst great care will be taken whilst handling the work, the Cathedral cannot be held responsible for its loss or damage.

2. By entering your work for the exhibition, you are agreeing that the Cathedral may use images of your work to promote the exhibition, both in advance, during and after its showing.
3. Works of art in the exhibition will not be offered for sale. Should the Cathedral receive enquiries, these will be passed on to the artist concerned.
